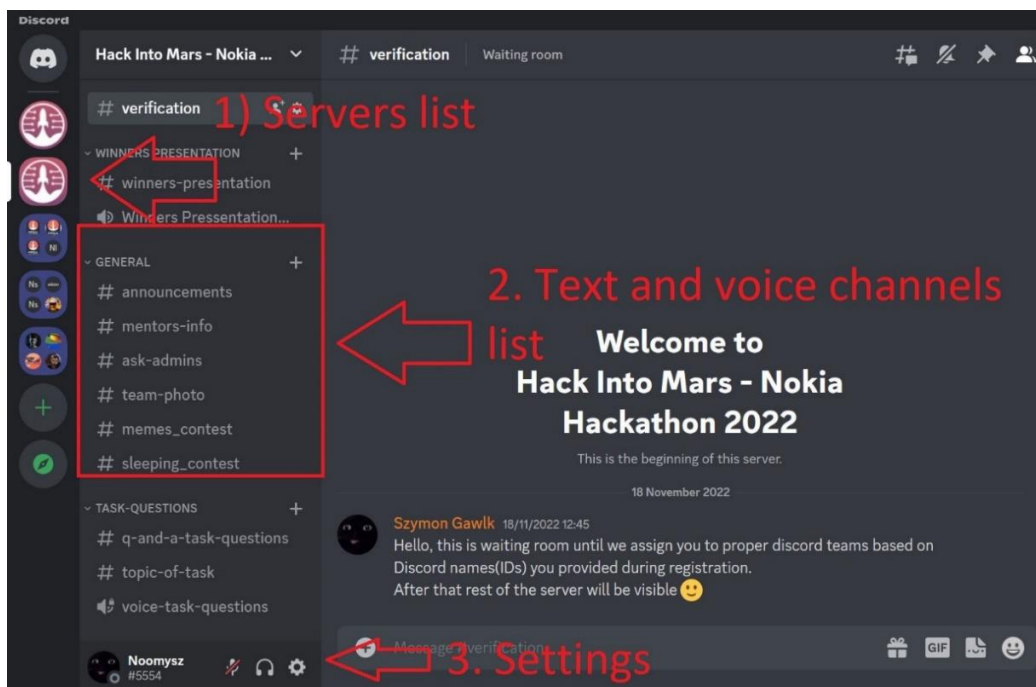


Discord instruction

1) Basic info

Discord is an easy-to-use tool. It can be used with dedicated Discord application or by browser. To get to a given server, just click the invitation link. To enter the server on the Discord application, click on it in the list on the left (1). Similarly, to enter a specific channel on the server, just click on its name (2). Voice channel also allows sharing the screen or camera. At the bottom left, next to the username, there is an option to disable the microphone and sound, and user settings containing detailed account settings such as name, sound or notifications (3).



2) Verification

Depending on the assigned role, the view and access to specific voice and text channels may be different. By default all new users can only see **'verification'** channel. Based on user name you provided during registration administrator will grant you access to other channels, including your team`s text and voice channel.

3) Communication with mentors

There will be channel to ask mentors generic questions about tasks or report setup problems, but during hackathon recommended is by recall mentors to your team channel, which cannot be seen by other teams.

To recall a specific person or group, enter '@Name' in the text chat, for example: '@Admin'. When someone will try to recall you, that will be displayed as a notification from Discord application.

For any question or problems not related with the task there is also special channel 'ask-admins'.
